Position Description: We are currently in need of energetic dance instructors to lead school-based dance classes for students in grades K-8. Applicants must have a background in dance (any style) and previous teaching experience. You will receive training on our curriculum.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Engage and empower students through dance education
- Teach a structured dance class appropriate for grade/age level of students
- Choreograph a short piece representative of work in class upon request

Position Requirements:

- Weekday availability between 2-6pm
- Willing to travel in the city to teach, especially South Side as we have a heavy concentration of programs in this region
- Great rapport with people, especially kids
- Strong dance background of any kind

Qualifications

Education: High school or equivalent (Preferred)

Experience: Teaching: 2-3 years (Preferred)

Hours: These are part-time positions (typically 2-8 hours per week, Monday - Friday), and applicants must have reliable transportation. All instructors must also pass a background check and complete mandatory training requirements.
